MEN'S THURSDAY AFTERNOON LEAGUE

The league is open to golfers of all abilities and provides a fun atmosphere to enhance your membership. It includes individual matches within rows on drafted teams. For more information contact the Pro Shop at cloquetcc@qmail.com or 218.879.7997

Season:

- The draft is held the last Thursday in April.
- The first Thursday in May is the Spring Team Scramble and spring banquet.
- Play begins the second Thursday in May and continues through August. (Invite week off)
- Playoffs run into September with the Fall Team Scramble and banquet in late September.
- A schedule will be available in print and online at the Spring Banquet for the season.

Draft:

- Teams are drafted each April by team sponsors.
- Up to 2 sponsors can share and draft a team. Exceptions will be considered by the league.
- Teams may reserve a 3rd spot for an employee, but may be handicapped by the league (based on team strength) for their first selection.
- Most golfers are grouped by handicap & past performance into rows prior to the draft.
- Other golfers choose to play in handicapped rows that play at specific times.
- Team sponsors will draw for order each row.
- Draft night trades must be approved by the league before being finalized.

Format:

- Play will consist of individual matches of 9 or 18 holes, (determined by players)
- 18 points are available each match. 1 point per hole.
- If less than an 18 hole match is played, the holes not played will be split equally.
- Normal match play rules apply including splitting points on holes where ties occur.
- Players are encouraged to pick up on holes when needed to keep speed of play intact.
- Regular rows play "straight up" except if the league determines row integrity has changed.
- Handicapped rows will use USGA handicaps and any adjustments made by the league.
- Matches may be played before the match date if both players agree.
- It is the role of the player to locate a sub if they cannot play a match.
- Regular members can sub. If no match occurs, the available player will receive 12 points.
- Dinner tickets are awarded weekly to the highest team, and team points form playoff ranks.
- To qualify for drawings you need to have played a match. If you have a sub and your name is drawn the sub wins the drawing. If a league member subbed another name is drawn.

Playoffs:

- Team rankings are used to form brackets that play down each week to a final team.
- The top teams and individual row and league leaders are awarded at the fall banquet.

League Fees:

- \$125 per player includes league fee, weekly proximities & drawings, and 2 banquets.
- \$50 for subs include the above member benefits on days they are subbing.
- Team Sponsors are \$100 and include business promotions through the league and club.
- \$75 for new players for the first year and includes all rights of returning members.
